**1 Ford Island—Pacific Aviation Museum**

9 AM: GEO will start its first annual Electric Car Rally Hawaii at Ford Island's Pacific Aviation Museum. After opening remarks from the attending Dignitaries a select group of invited Electric Vehicles (EVs) will depart for Kaneohe MCBH via the engineering marvel that is the H-3 freeway.

**2 Marine Corps Base Hawaii**

10 AM: Arrive at Kaneohe MCBH. After test drives with the Dignitaries on base, we depart for Kailua.

**3 Kailua**

11 AM: Kailua Elementary School parking lot. Here we meet Rep. Cynthia Thielen and organizers of Hybrid owners who will join the Rally at this point. A few lucky people will get to go for a quick ride in the amazing Tesla Roadster in Kailua, before we all depart for the scenic and silent "glide" around Makapu'u Point arriving at...

**4 Hawaii Kai**

12 PM: Hawaii Kai at Maunaloa Bay Beach Park across from the intersection of Hawaii Kai Dr. and Kalaniana'ole Hwy. At this point we meet up with all the original Zero Emission Vehicles—Bicyclists—who wish to join us. Members of the Hawaii Kai Electric Boat club will give us a toot from their horns as we cross the bridge leaving Hawaii Kai for...

**5 Kahala Mall**

12:30 PM: Kahala Community Park at the corner of Pueo St. and Kilauea Ave—2 blocks from the Kahala Mall. We meet up with electric Low Speed Vehicles (LSVs) such as scooters, Segways, golf carts as well as both electric and manual bicyclists who wish to join. We go down Pueo and turn right on Kahala Ave. We proceed up to the Diamond Head Lookout for a brief photo shoot.

**6 Kapiolani Park**

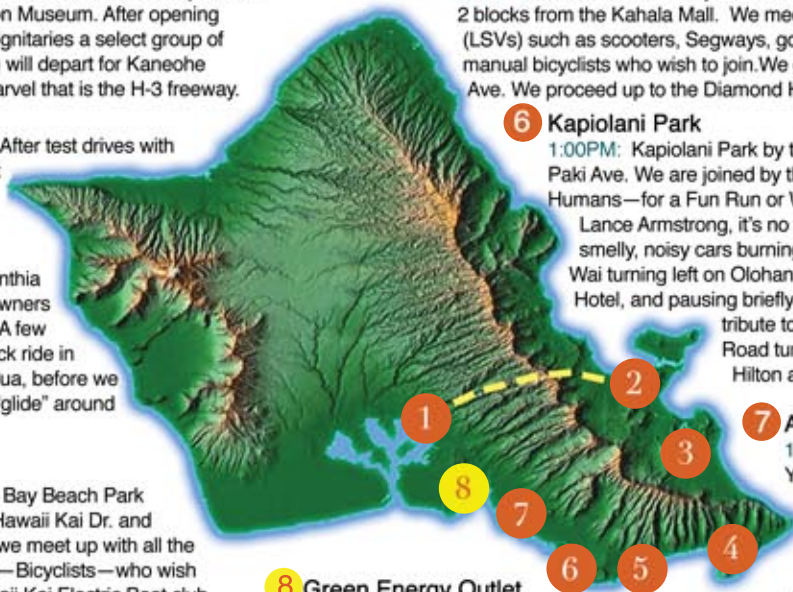
1:00 PM: Kapiolani Park by the Diamond Head Tennis Courts on Paki Ave. We are joined by the original Low Emission Vehicles—Humans—for a Fun Run or Walk in support of Green Energy.
